## The House, Garden & Collection

Located within Salisbury's magnificent Cathedral Close, this charming house with its Queen Anne facade began life as a Medieval Canonry and is the former home of Sir Edward Heath - former Prime Minister, statesman, yachtsman, musician and art collector.

Arundells remains home to Sir Edward's personal art collection including paintings by Sir Winston Churchill, John Singer-Sargent, Walter
Sickert, Augustus and Gwen John, L S Lowry, John Nash, John Piper and
William Wyllie. Exquisite Japanese woodblock prints, hand painted
Chinese wallpaper, ceramics, glassware, photographs and detailed scale
models of his five Morning Cloud yachts.









The collection also includes curios from around the world, quirky objet d'art and a whole corridor of humorous political cartoons.

Sir Edward's Steinway piano and music memorabilia are on display.

Pianists are very welcome play the piano.

The peaceful garden, with lawns, mature trees and borders, has spectacular views of the spire of Salisbury Cathedral, and the confluence of the River Avon and the River Nadder.




## Visiting us



## OPTION ONE - GUIDED TOURS

Led by one of our expert guides, tours of the house are available on Tuesdays from 19th March for larger groups and coach parties.

In addition, and although not advertised as being open, we will also be pleased to arrange guided tours for larger groups and coach parties on Wednesdays.

The charge for guided tours by larger groups (12 people and above) on both Tuesdays and Wednesdays is £11 per person – a £2 reduction on the full price. Admission to the garden and exhibition room is included.

### OPTION TWO - EXPLORE AT YOUR LEISURE

Your group can explore the house and garden at their leisure (and at their own pace) with our friendly and knowledgeable stewards on hand to answer any questions and printed room guides for each part of the house.

The 2024 season begins on Thursday 14th March and we'll be open for "explore at your leisure visits" on Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Mondays.

The group (12 people +) admission charge on these days is £8.00 per person – a reduction of £2.00 against the advertised price. Admission to the garden and exhibition room is included.
